AGRICULTURAL MACHINERY AND EQUIPMENT CLASSES

1. Hay handling equipment
2. Spraying equipment
3. Mounted and pull type tractor equipment

ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT CLASSES

1. Show and livestock equipment (electrical only)
2. Shop tools and equipment (electrical only)
1st place project for Division

LIVESTOCK EQUIPMENT CLASSES (Classes 13-18 for domesticated livestock only.)

1. Gates and livestock panels
2. Squeeze chutes and restraining equipment
3. Trim chutes, blocking stands, livestock crates, and headgates
4. Feeders
5. Self- feeders and creep feeders
6. Other equipment for domesticated livestock
7. Equipment for wildlife and exotic animals (Limited to equipment used to produce and manage animals such as deer, llama, turkeys, quail, fish, etc. including deer stands, timed-tripod feeders, hog traps, or other hunting equipment.)

TRAILER CLASSES

1. Small utility trailers – 10 ft. and under in length
2. Utility trailers – over 10 ft. in length
3. Non-traditional utility and implement trailers – all lengths*
4. Stock trailers

7. Gooseneck flatbed utility and implement trailers

* Non-traditional utility and implement trailers will include drop-bed trailers, trailers without side rails, and other special purpose trailers that do not fit into the traditional trailer classes.

** Dump trailers, regardless of length, will be exhibited in class 30.

Ribbons to be awarded in all classes through six places.

1. Projects must be built during the present school year, exhibited by junior exhibitors presently active in 4-H Clubs or FFA Chapters.
2. No limit as to number of projects exhibited by individuals, classes or organizations.
3. Projects exhibited may be sold by exhibitor at private treaty.
4. First place division winners compete for Grand Champion trophy.
5. Both overall Grand and Reserve Grand projects will have the option to enter the sale, if they decline then the next highest project will have the option. Two projects will sale with no minimum bid.
6. All shop projects will be judged on a point system.
