

HCLS QUEEN CONTESTANT RULES

1. This contest is open to any young lady, in an FFA chapter or 4H club who is eligible to participate in the Henderson County Livestock Show. Each Contestant must participate in at least one other Livestock Show Division.
2. The Queen must be 14-19 years of age as of Aug.31 of the current school year and will be selected for poise, personality and attire. There will be an interview and a modeling session as part of the selection process. In addition, each contestant will be given a scrapbook which must be turned in at the interview. This scrapbook will be used to show the day to day activities in which the contestant is involved. It may highlight school and extracurricular activities.
3. A club or chapter may have more than one Queen Contestant.
4. The Queen must be present at all contests for awards presentation and help in other activities as she is asked to do so by the Livestock Show; represent the Livestock Show in fairs, rodeos, parades, etc. throughout the year and be present for the crowning of the following year's Queen.
5. The Queen and winners of all categories will be required to work during the HCLS Premium Auction. Any absences must have board approval in advance. Any contestants absent without board approval will be disqualified.
6. Applications are available on the association website, hclsathens.com. Send entries to queen contestant superintendent. Deadline for all entries will be posted annually on the association website.
7. Judges for the queen contest must not reside in Henderson County, unless approved by the board.
