

HCLS LIVESTOCK JUDGING CONTEST

1. This contest is open to all 4-H and FFA members.
2. A trophy will be awarded to the first place junior (9 thru 13) and the first place senior (14 and over) team and to the high point junior and senior individuals. Ribbons will be awarded to teams and high point individuals through six places in both junior and senior divisions.
3. The contest will be conducted Saturday starting at 9:00 a.m.
4. Three or four members may constitute a team. The three high scores will constitute the team score.
5. In case of a tie, highest scores in questions will determine winner; if still a tie, highest scores in placings on question classes will determine winner; if still a tie, a total number of perfect scores in either placings or questions will determine winner. **Revised 7/17/2023**
6. There will be a minimum of 8 classes of which 3 will be question classes consisting of 5 questions per class. **Revised 7/17/2023**
7. A classes will consist of four animals. **Revised 7/20/2015**
8. Ten minutes will be allowed to judge each class. Two minutes will be allowed between classes to move.
9. The contest superintendent will have the responsibility for selecting animals for classes and selecting judge or judges to make official placing.
10. All animals at the show will be available for the Livestock Judging Contest upon notification of the owner. If the owner cannot be reached, the 4-H or FFA leader must be notified.
